Mayor Kilsheimer called the special City Council meeting to order at 7:21 p.m.

CONSENT AGENDA

1. Authorize issuance of a Vehicle-For-Hire Permit, to be valid for one year, to Lil Bit's Academy, owned by Antoinette Wright, to operate a 12-passenger van to transport students to field trips or after-school activities.

Mayor Kilsheimer said this was a special meeting called to authorize a Consent Agenda item to authorize issuance of a Vehicle-For-Hire Permit.

Mr. Irby said this is termed a Peddler's Permit and is normally under the Consent Agenda of a regular meeting. He advised this went to DRC last week, but it was not a full and complete application. She was not able to submit all required documents in time to be on last week's agenda. We now have all of that information and so not to delay her being able to work we have placed it on an agenda for tonight. She has qualified and passed all tests required. Staff recommends approval.

MOTION by Commissioner Arrowsmith and seconded by Commissioner Dean to approve the Vehicle-For-Hire Permit to Lil Bit's Academy, owned by Antoinette Wright, to operate a 12 passenger van to transport students.
